Bread for the World 2021 Offering of Letters

Let our elected officials know your views on important issues

Dear St. Andrew family,

Bread for the World's annual "Offering of Letters" is now underway. Over the years, these letters and emails to our elected officials in Washington, DC from congregations like ours, as well as campuses and community groups, have helped inspire our leaders to pass legislation that enables people to feed their families and move out of poverty.

This year's topic

Bread's topic for this year's letters is the expanded Child Tax Credit (CTC), whereby families can receive a \$3,000 annual benefit per child aged 6 to 17, and \$3,600 per child under the age of 6 for the 2021 tax year. The expanded credit is set to end after 2021.

Some groups would like to make the expanded CTC permanent, stating that it could reduce poverty in the US by 45 percent. Others believe it is an expansion of the welfare state that may disincentivize some parents from working, making it tougher to reduce poverty.

Let your feelings known

Write a letter or email to your US House of Representatives and Senate members letting them know your thoughts on the expanded CTC. Or, you may want to address other issues that are near and dear to you.

Personalized letters or emails tell senators and representatives that you, as a constituent, really care about an issue. They want to hear from their constituents about the issues on which they will vote.

Make it personal. Describe what motivated you to write

Make your request clear.
