No experience or particular skills are necessary to work on the site. Must be at least 16 years old to participate.



Each December on "National Wreaths Across America Day," volunteers place wreaths at veterans' gravesites at Arlington National Cemetery, as well as at more than 3,400 additional locations in all 50 U.S. states, at sea and abroad.

This year's event will be held on Saturday, December 17. The day will begin at 9 a.m. with a special ceremony, followed by the laying of wreaths.

The closest participating cemetery to Whittier is Memory Garden Memorial Park, 455 W. Central Ave., Brea

(right next to La Habra). The cemetery is small so the process of laying the wreaths typically takes about an hour, depending on the number of volunteers.
