On Wednesday, December 21 in the City of Whittier Council Chambers at 6PM the Parks and Recreation and Community Services Commission will hold a public hearing to consider the appeal of the Parks Department intention to remove 5 massive Indian Laurel trees (Ficus microcarpa) to make way for a 5 story, residential only, project.

The appeal was filed by David Dickerson, chair of the Urban Forest Committee of the Whittier Conservancy.
