St. Andrew to sponsor two missionary families

St. Andrew has a long history of supporting missionaries across the globe. We will now be reviving that tradition, as your Church Council voted last month to fund two missionary families.

The first of those is Reverend Wal Luot Reat, an ELCA missionary who focuses on evangelism as he serves with South Sudanese in refugee camps in Ethiopia, South Sudan and bordering countries. Sudan's history of civil war, instability and violence has forced many people to flee their homes. As of June 2023, there were 2.3 million displaced people in South Sudan. Reverend Reat was born in Sudan and lived in refugee camps in Sudan, Ethiopia and Kenya before resettling in the US in 1995. He and his wife, Nyakuich, have one son and three daughters.



The second of our missionary families is Joel and Lea, workers with World Misson Prayer League (WMPL) serving in Bangladesh. WMPL is an independent Lutheran mission society and prayer fellowship that sends missionaries to 20 countries in Latin America, Africa, Asia, Europe and North America. The mission of the League is to evangelize and plant churches where Christ is unknown or little known and few global workers are serving, or where traditional workers cannot go. Joel teaches Bible, provides pastoral care, and equips congregations and leaders to reach out to their neighbors with the Good News. His wife, Lea, serves at Lutheran Aid to Medicine hospital in Bangladesh, and is dedicated to improving the health of mothers and children. She advocates for nurses and midwives throughout the region (via Nurses Christian Fellowship), and equips them to be competent and compassionate caregivers.

We will be sponsoring each missionary family for \$1,000 for 2024, and will be re-evaluating those relationships after one year. The sponsorships are being funded by our Thrivent Choice Dollars account. Thrivent Choice Dollars are dollars made available to eligible clients from Thrivent's charitable outreach funds. Our members who receive these funds have directed them to St. Andrew to be used where we feel they can make the best impact.

With our \$1,000 donation to Reverend Reat, we will be considered a "Covenant Congregation" with the ELCA, where, along with that financial support, we will commit to a promise of prayer and communications, receive regular updates from him, and have the opportunity to request a visit during his home assignment.
